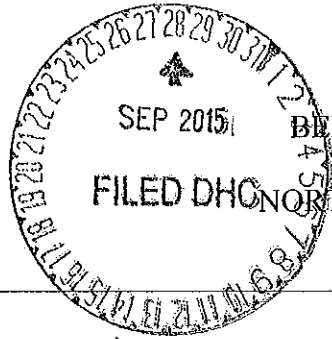

ORDER STAYING SUSPENSION

THIS MATTER is before the Secretary of the North Carolina State Bar pursuant to a Petition for Order Staying Suspension filed by Jason Alfred Matthew Gold (“Gold”) on August 27, 2015.

Based upon the petition and a review of the records of the North Carolina State Bar, the Secretary makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 26, 2013, a hearing panel of the Disciplinary Hearing Commission (“DHC”) entered an Order of Discipline in 12 DHC 34 (“Order of Discipline”) suspending Gold from the practice of law for five years effective on the date of the Order of Discipline. The Order of Discipline provided that, after serving two years of active suspension, Gold could apply for a stay of the balance of the suspension if he satisfied certain conditions.

2. On August 27, 2015, Gold filed a petition for reinstatement showing that he had satisfied the conditions set forth in the Order of Discipline for him to be eligible for a stay and the conditions set forth in 27 NCAC 1B, § .0125(b) to be reinstated.

3. Counsel for the North Carolina State Bar did not file an objection to Gold’s petition.

BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact, the Secretary makes the following:

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. The Petitioner, Jason Alfred Matthew Gold, has satisfied the requirements set out in his Order of Discipline to have the balance of his suspension stayed; and
2. Jason Alfred Matthew Gold has satisfied the requirements of 27 NCAC 1B, § .0125(b) to be entitled to reinstatement of his license to practice law in this jurisdiction.

BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, the Secretary enters the following:

ORDER STAYING SUSPENSION

The balance of Jason Alfred Matthew Gold's suspension is hereby stayed and Jason Alfred Matthew Gold is reinstated to the active practice of law in North Carolina as of the date of this order.
